

# How to search efficiently in pdf-documents



### “Regulation 12A – Oil fuel tank protection

... regulation shall apply to all ships with an aggregate oil fuel capacity of 600 m<sup>3</sup> and which are delivered on or after 1 August 2010, as defined in regulation 1.28.9 c

... the purpose of this regulation, the following definitions shall apply:


“Oil fuel” means any oil used as fuel oil in connection with the propulsion and auxiliary machinery of the ship in which such oil is carried.

“Load line draught (ds)” is the vertical distance, in metres, from the moulded baseline at mid-length to the waterline corresponding to the summer freeboard draught to be assigned.

“Light ship draught” is the draught of a ship when light to the draught of the lightweight.
